Bowmer + Kirkland has been selected as the main contractor for Helena Romanes School's new site and are asking the community for their feedback on revised proposals.

A planning application for the new site was approved in 2021, however, amendments have become necessary to enable the deliverability of the school, in particular the primary school, as soon as possible and to ensure compliance with the latest DfE standards.

The revised plans retain the main design principles of the consented scheme, are considered to comply with the local plan and retain the approved access which is adjacent to Buttleys Lane off Stortford Road, Great Dunmow.

The project team has been working with the school to prepare the proposals and would like to invite local people to review the plans at a public exhibition or via our website.
